Notes – Please read before signing overleaf

- All images of youngsters can be accessed by the parent/guardians if required (2 week notice must be given).
- ***If parental consent is revoked all images of their child must be erased or destroyed. No image shall remain of their child by any club official.***
- It is part of the British Cycling's coaches code of conduct and codes of ethics to ensure that reasonable steps are taken to establish a safe environment where the youngsters can enjoy developing their cycling skills.
- All Hetton Hawks Saturday sessions will take place on traffic free areas. Youngsters are expected to remain in the session from beginning to end, unless they are being collected or their parent/guardian have informed the coach that they may leave earlier.
- Parents/guardians are encouraged to stay and watch the sessions.
- Any youngster who persistently misbehaves or puts others in danger will be asked to leave the sessions. They will not be allowed to attend future sessions.
- The information collected will be stored securely on computer and will be shared with club committee members and coaches only to aid the smooth running of the club. If you require a copy of the information held, please contact any committee member or coach.
- It is the parents/guardians responsibility to ensure that their Child's bike is in a safe condition to ride.
- A cycle helmet to the approved standard must be worn at all times during the coaching session.
- Parents/guardians will be informed in advance of any session that takes place away from Hetton Lyons Country Park or on public roads. Special permission will be sort if such a session is going to take place.
- To encourage participation in cycling, the club provides club kit to first claim members upon participation in 5 coaching sessions.
- The club and first claim members are sponsored and supported by private enterprise companies. As such members must project a positive image whilst wearing or representing the club during sessions/races or whilst wearing kit.

Hetton Hawks Club Kit Agreement

Hetton Hawks Cycling Club has secured the support of One North East (ONE) and K Home International Ltd to provide cycling kit to club members. ONE and K Home International Ltd are keen to promote youth cycling in the region. Both ONE and K Home International Ltd recognize that the purchase of cycling kit can be costly and by enabling Hetton Hawks CC to provide club kit free of charge, one of the inhibitors to entry into cycling is eliminated.

The kit, (shorts and short sleeved shirts), provided to members is on a loan basis. The loan of the kit to members enables the club to recycle the kit within the club and ensure that all members are able to benefit from wearing club colours.

1. *Members of Hetton Hawks shall at all times promote the name of the sponsors in a positive way.*
2. *Hetton Hawks and its members shall not misuse or mis-represent the sponsors name or image in any way.*
3. *Any member of Hetton Hawks either currently under suspension or in the future with any recognised body is also automatically prevented from using any kit with the Club or sponsor name for any purpose whatsoever.*
4. *On taking delivery of their strip, all Hetton Hawks CC members must sign a declaration stating their intention to adhere to the above points*
